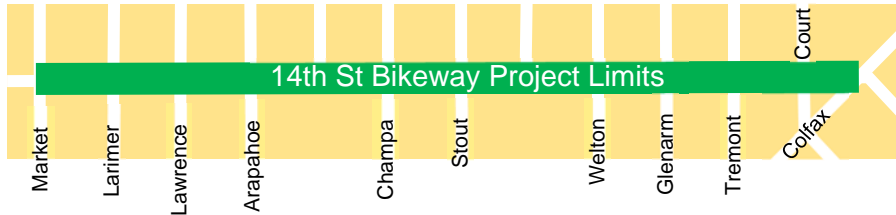


Bikeway Improvements Coming to 14th Street

Bike Lane and Parking impacts anticipated July 5 – July 28

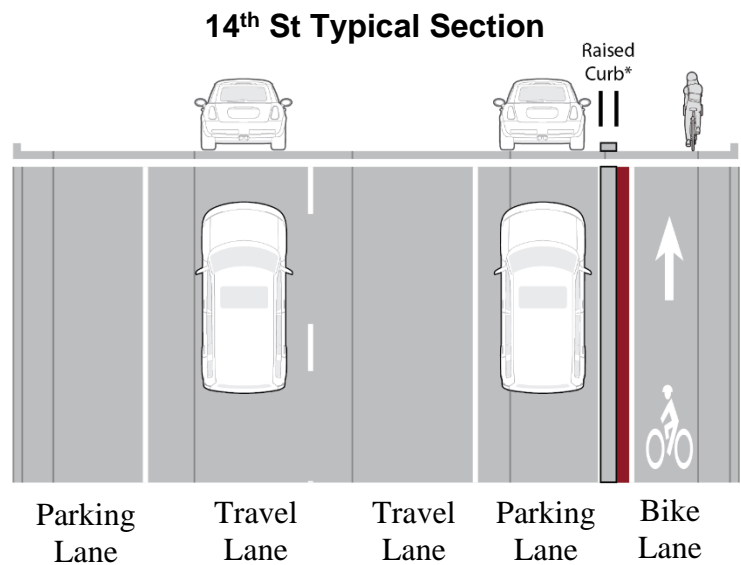


Beginning **Wednesday, July 5 at 7:00pm**, Denver Public Works will begin installing a parking-protected bike lane on 14th Street from Market St to Court Place, as well as a buffered bike lane from Court Place to Colfax Avenue.

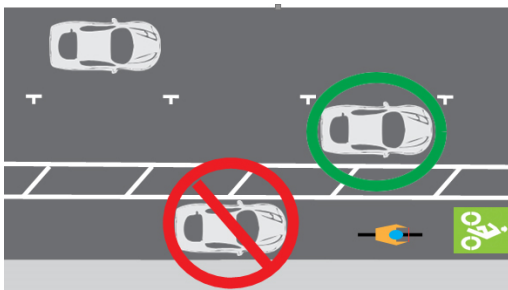
The installation will result in both temporary and permanent parking restrictions along the right side of the street starting on July 5th. Construction is expected to last about three weeks.

These bike lane improvements will enhance safety for people on bikes by providing an additional buffer between bicycle and vehicle traffic along 14th Street. The image below shows how 14th Street will look when the parking-protected bike lanes is complete.

The public's patience and cooperation during construction is greatly appreciated. All work is weather dependent and subject to change.



New Parking Configuration Along 14th Street from Market Street to Court Place



The parking-protected bikeway will use a row of parking to separate bicycle traffic from vehicle traffic. Drivers park in the dedicated parking lane and cross the bike lane on foot to get on the sidewalk.
