

## **DRESS CODE**

Red Rocks ONLY\*

The Dress Code for performance times (opening of doors to public until the conclusion of the event) remains blacks, venue logo's only, or solid.

## Load in/out:

**Shirts:** Neutral solid colored shirts (no tank tops) with no logos except Red Rocks logo provided by the venue, Red Rocks show shirts or IATSE National or Local 7 shirts with bug only. Shirts must in in good condition, no tears or fading.

**Pants/Shorts:** Neutral solid (no fatigue) color pants or shorts in good condition with no tears and no logos. Shorts should hit near the knee.

**Hats:** Hat's with no logos except venue specific. Hard hats are to be worn during any overhead working. Eyes: Sunglasses / eye protection are allowed during the daylight hours.

**Safety Vests:** Safety vests must be worn when working around moving vehicles (loaders / pushers). STRONGLY SUGGESTED SAFETY ITEMS

**Footwear:** Footwear must cover the full foot, it is strongly encouraged to wear protective shoe wear when working around heavy equipment that can be dropped or rolled.

**Gloves:** Hand protection is <u>strongly encouraged</u> when carrying items, when there are pinch hazards, or in inclement weather.

**Ears:** Ear protection is available in the crew room for your use anytime.
